Program Description

Why You Should Participate:

The National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program has been an ongoing effort that offers AGC members an opportunity to evaluate their safety record. Participating contractors receive a confidential printout to compare their company's safety statistics with similar size and type AGC contractor members. This information can be used to assist in determining if additional accident prevention and loss control measures are necessary. Additionally, NASA provides a great opportunity for contractor members to compete for nationally recognized awards for incident rates below 25% of their division rate and zero incident rates. Recognition will consist of certificates of commendation.

Who Can Participate:

AGC contractors **with direct-hire, job-site craft labor** are eligible to compete in one or more of the following categories: Building, Heavy/ Highway, Municipal/Utilities and Specialty/ Subcontractor members.

Complete Participant Form and Fax or Email back. (See bottom of page.).

Complete your OSHA form 300A "Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses" for 2011. Record your OSHA form 300A sections (G) through (J) and the "Employment Information" section for your company's total work hours (include both office and field).

*** A company must participate in the National AGC Safety Awards for three consecutive years (2009, 2010 and 2011) to be eligible for awards.**
