We believe that when you change a child's life, you change a family's, which can change a community, and ultimately the world.

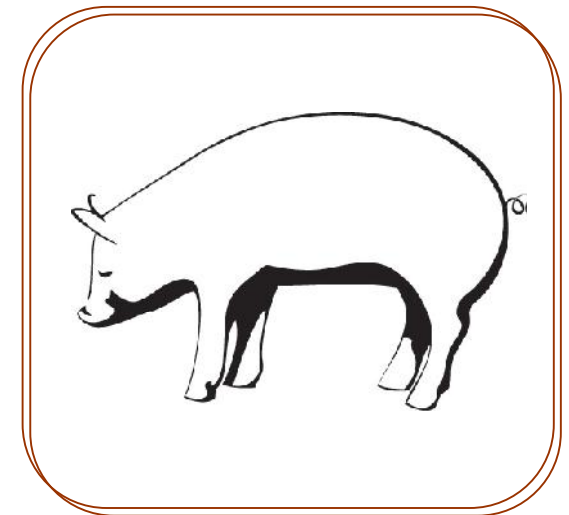
