

Turner Honored for Safety Excellence by Association of General Contractors

The Association of General Contractors (AGC) awarded Turner a top honor at its annual construction Safety and Excellence Awards (CSEA). Turner placed first in the building construction division for large general contractors in the four million hours worked category.

The AGC Construction Safety and Excellence Awards recognize companies who have developed and implemented excellent safety and loss prevention programs achieved through management commitment, employee involvement and program innovation.

The CSEA judges examine each company's commitment to safety and occupational health management and risk control. Unlike the National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program that limits the criteria to frequency rates, the CSEA selection process is considerably more comprehensive. Judges look for evidence of company management commitment, active employee participation, safety training, work site hazard identification and control and safety program innovation.

Members of the AGC Safety and Health Committee then review the submittals and the finalists in each category give an oral presentation in front of five judges for first, second or third place.
